Flexi-Care & Full Day Programmes

At Chiltern House Preschool, we take on this shared caretaking role in a partnership with parents very seriously. Building on our existing Half-Day programme, the Flexi-Care and Full Day curriculum have been carefully tailored and designed by our team of experienced early childhood educators, with contribution from our Singapore senior team, to provide the best balance in terms of skills and environment to the highest standard of education.

Both programmes aim to offer parents a one-stop learning institution offering a stimulating yet nurturing environment where your child will be equipped with the life skills needed for the future as supervised by our specialised early childhood educators.

This brochure will help you decide which programme best suits your child's learning in his/her own time and unique way.

Routine Care

During Flexi-Care and Full Day, your children will undergo basic routine care to ensure that their needs are cared for, as part of their journey towards independence.

Oral Hygiene

Right after their lunch time, the children will upkeep their oral hygiene through teeth-brushing and mouth-washing under the supervision of our teachers on duty.

Rest / Quiet Time

It is absolutely essential that your children receive enough down time during their designated nap or rest time to rejuvenate so that they will be alert and refreshed to continue with their discoveries and explorations for the day.



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)



1. **My child has already established his/her nap time at home. How will this work?**

Children are incredibly adaptable and often, transitions can be achieved with ease. It may take each child different lengths of time to get themselves adjusted to the new nap or rest routine but rest assure that over time, they will be able to make the change. Our teachers will be on hand to ensure that your children receives the rest they need to continue with their learning for the day. And if your child decides not to take a nap, he/she may choose to unwind and take a rest instead.

2. **Will lunch be provided?**

Lunch is provided by the school's caterer and served in a communal area. We do not encourage you to bring your own food unless your child suffers from specific food allergies in which you are required to then inform your child's class teachers. In such cases, kindly ensure the food adheres to the school's guidelines, including no non-halal food. Payment for lunch is to be made directly to the caterer. Any changes to the lunch menu will be informed to you ahead of time to the best of our ability so that you can plan for your child's lunch accordingly if necessary.

3. **How many students will there be in a class?**

A full class can accommodate up to 14 students at a time.



Additional Flexi-Care and Full Day Programmes

1. **Project! Project! (English)**

The children are immersed in the entire process of managing a project or campaign, from selecting the theme to its execution. Through this exercise, they are exposed to the stages of planning, creative thinking, and of working in a team.

2. **Chinese Cultural Arts (Mandarin) - 中华民族艺术课**

Through music, dance, drama, art and stories, Cultural Arts gives our young learners insight into Chinese culture while enabling them to absorb Standard Mandarin in a fun and exciting arts-rich environment. The children are led through a series of expressive disciplines including calligraphy and Chinese brush painting, traditional Chinese handicrafts, and preparing and tasting traditional Chinese food.

3. **Language Learners (Mandarin) - 华语提高班**

In this programme, engaging activities including drama, storytelling, music and movement, art and craft, and writing practice make developing competency in the four components of language learning (speaking, listening, reading and writing) a fun and enjoyable process.

4. **Creative Writing (English)**

Creative Writing aims to expand a child's creativity and effectively uses their vivid imagination to incorporate their experience in drama, to produce creative outcomes in their writings. The programme aims to cultivate an early interest in literature and enthusiasm for writing.
